To receive and maintain your vessel certification there are certain additional records you must keep updated on a regular basis. Depending on your fisheries and operations, there maybe addition records you must keep updated regularly.

These can be assessed and managed through a document management and record keeping system or by paper records.

Remember grant aid is available through the Sustainable Fisheries Scheme under the following:
